AN ACT

RELATING TO FILM; REDUCING THE TERM LENGTHS FOR MEMBERS OF THE GOVERNOR'S COUNCIL ON FILM AND MEDIA INDUSTRIES FROM FOUR YEARS TO TWO YEARS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 9-15-4.1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2003, Chapter 97, Section 1, as amended) is amended to read:

"9-15-4.1. GOVERNOR'S COUNCIL ON FILM AND MEDIA INDUSTRIES--CREATED--MEMBERSHIP--EXECUTIVE BOARD.--

A. The "governor's council on film and media industries" is created to advise the department and the governor on ways to promote film production in New Mexico, assist in the design and implementation of the department's strategic plan for building a media infrastructure in the state, assist in designing a workforce training program for

1 film production and make recommendations for incentives and
2 funding for these efforts.

3 B. The governor's council on film and media
4 industries shall be composed of no more than thirty members
5 appointed by the governor for [~~four-year~~] two-year staggered
6 terms; provided that the initial appointments shall be made so
7 that one-half of the members shall be appointed for two-year
8 terms and one-half of the members shall be appointed for four-
9 year terms. Terms shall expire on January 1.

10 C. From the membership of the governor's council on
11 film and media industries, the governor shall appoint a seven-
12 member "executive board". At least five members of the
13 executive board shall have experience in some aspect of film
14 production. The executive board shall:

15 (1) with the approval of the secretary, create
16 subcommittees of the governor's council on film and media
17 industries and name the [~~chairmen~~] chairs of those
18 subcommittees;

19 (2) coordinate activities of the subcommittees
20 and the governor's council on film and media industries; and

21 (3) develop recommendations pertaining to the
22 charges of the governor's council on film and media industries
23 for the consideration of the governor's council on film and
24 media industries.

25 D. The governor shall name the [~~chairman~~] chair of

1 the governor's council on film and media industries, who shall
2 serve as the [~~chairman~~] chair of the executive board. The
3 governor's council on film and media industries may elect such
4 other officers as it deems necessary. The governor's council
5 on film and media industries shall meet at the call of the
6 [~~chairman~~] chair, at least quarterly. Members of the
7 governor's council on film and media industries may receive per
8 diem and mileage for travel within New Mexico as provided in
9 the Per Diem and Mileage Act, but shall receive no other
10 compensation, perquisite or allowance.

11 E. Staff for the governor's council on film and
12 media industries shall be provided by the department.

13 F. The governor's council on film and media
14 industries shall report to the department, the governor and the
15 legislature by December 1 of each year on its activities and
16 recommendations."

17 Section 2. TEMPORARY PROVISION--TERMS.--Notwithstanding
18 the term-length amendment to Section 9-15-4.1 NMSA 1978 in this
19 2008 act, the terms of members appointed in 2007 shall expire
20 on January 1, 2010.

21 Section 3. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the
22 provisions of this act is January 1, 2009.
