AN ACT

MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR AN ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT SITE
LOCATED IN MCKINLEY COUNTY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--Five hundred thousand dollars
(\$500,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the
economic development department for expenditure in fiscal year
2009 to undertake, in cooperation with the veterans' services
department, a feasibility study for and to plan and design an
economic development site located in McKinley county, which
shall include a veterans' services center and health care
facility, commercial components, a museum and a national
cemetery. The museum shall serve as the showcase for the
Navajo code talkers' legacy. Any unexpended or unencumbered
balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2009 shall revert
