14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
15	Section 1. APPROPRIATIONOne million five hundred
16	thousand dollars (\$1,500,000) is appropriated from the general
17	fund to the interstate stream commission for expenditure in
18	fiscal year 2009 to support a multi-stakeholder planning
19	process in developing a plan to optimize the 2004 Arizona Water
20	Settlements Act in a cost-effective manner that will balance
21	historical and future demands for water against an uncertain
22	supply while protecting the environment. Any unexpended or
23	unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2009
24	shall revert to the general fund.
