CAPITAL PROJECTS FOR REPRESENTATIVE ANTONIO LUJAN

I request that the following be funded:

- to the aging and long-term services department

DONA ANA CO SAN MIGUEL SENIOR CMTY CTR

three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for improvements, including upgrades to comply with the Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990, at the San Miguel senior community center in Dona Ana county

- to the border authority

SANTA TERESA POE RAIL CROSSING

three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for a feasibility study and plan for the issuance of a presidential permit for the railyard and maintenance facility at the Santa Teresa port of entry in Dona Ana county, including related engineering, environmental and financial feasibility, related requirements for a new railroad crossing and an extension of railroad infrastructure to the border

- to the capital program fund

SANTA TERESA BORDER AUTHORITY HEADQUARTERS

five hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$550,000) to design, construct, equip, furnish, landscape and make site improvements at the office headquarters facility of the border authority in Santa Teresa in Dona Ana county

SANTA TERESA SAFETY INSPECTION STATION

six million dollars (\$6,000,000) to plan, design and construct a safety inspection station at the Santa Teresa port of entry in Santa Teresa in Dona Ana county

- to the department of environment

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LAS CRUCES GRIGGS & WALNUT SUPERFUND SITE INFRA

one million six hundred thousand dollars (\$1,600,000) to plan, design and construct infrastructure, including a ground water well, piping and treatment equipment, for the Griggs and Walnut superfund site in Las Cruces in Dona Ana county

LAS CRUCES GRIGGS/WALNUT SUPERFUND SITE REMEDIATE

five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) for remediation of the Griggs-Walnut superfund site in Las Cruces in Dona Ana county

- to the department of transportation

DONA ANA CO SCHOOL ZONE FLASHING LIGHTS CONSTRUCT

one hundred ten thousand dollars (\$110,000) to plan, design and construct school zone flashing lights in Dona Ana county

- to the local government division of the department of finance and administration

ALB DANCE FACILITY LOW-INCOME/DISABLED

twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to plan, design, purchase, construct, renovate, equip and furnish a dance facility for use by a modern dance organization serving low-income, disabled and incarcerated youth and adults in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county

DONA ANA CO YOUTH TRANSITIONAL LIVING FACILITY

one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to purchase, plan, design, construct, equip and furnish a transitional living facility for youth in Dona Ana county

DONA ANA CO FAMILY CENTER ADDITION

two million two hundred thousand dollars (\$2,200,000) to plan, design and construct an addition to a county family residency center in Las Cruces in Dona Ana county

LAS CRUCES ANIMAL SHELTER CONSTRUCT & IMPROVE

five hundred thousand dollars (\$500,000) to plan, design, construct, improve and furnish the city animal shelter in Las Cruces in Dona Ana county

LAS CRUCES BRANIGAN LIBRARY CHILDREN'S WING

three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) to plan, design and construct a children's wing at the Branigan public library in Las Cruces in Dona Ana county

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LAS CRUCES DOWNTOWN PLAZA CONSTRUCT

two million five hundred thousand dollars (\$2,500,000) to plan, design and construct the downtown plaza in Las Cruces in Dona Ana county

LAS CRUCES HOMELESS VETERANS HOUSING COMPLEX

one hundred eighty-three thousand three hundred dollars (\$183,300) to design, construct, renovate and expand a housing complex for homeless veterans in Las Cruces in Dona Ana county

LAS CRUCES MESQUITE COMMUNITY GARDEN

one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to plan, design, construct and equip a community garden in the Mesquite historic district in Las Cruces in Dona Ana county

LAS CRUCES SHELTER & TRANSITIONAL HOUSING

seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) to plan, construct, equip and furnish renovations and additions, including heating, ventilation and air conditioning, to the city-owned La Casa shelter and transitional housing facilities in Las Cruces in Dona Ana county

SANTA TERESA EMERGENCY RESPONSE STATION

one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) to plan, design, purchase land for and construct a county emergency response station to provide hazmat and emergency response to the Santa Teresa port of entry and the surrounding area in Dona Ana county

NMSU KRWG EQUIP TO CONVERT TO DIGITAL

forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) to purchase and upgrade equipment for KRWG to convert to digital at New Mexico state university in Las Cruces in Dona Ana county

NMSU RECYCLING CENTER

ninety-six thousand four hundred fifty-eight dollars (\$96,458) to equip and furnish the recycling center at New Mexico state university in Las Cruces in Dona Ana county

GADSDEN MID SCHL HEALTH CLINIC OFFICE EQUIP

twenty-five thousand dollars (\$25,000) to purchase office equipment for the Gadsden middle school health clinic in the Gadsden independent school district in Dona Ana county

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
