6	Section 1. Section 14-9A-5 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2007,
7	Chapter 261, Section 5) is amended to read:
8	"14-9A-5. ADMINISTRATION AND STANDARDS
9	A. The information technology commission and the
10	state commission of public records, in consultation with the
11	county clerks of New Mexico, shall adopt standards to
12	implement the Uniform Real Property Electronic Recording Act.
13	B. To keep the standards and practices of county
14	clerks in this state in harmony with the standards and
15	practices of recording offices in other jurisdictions that
16	enact substantially the Uniform Real Property Electronic
17	Recording Act and to keep the technology used by county
18	clerks in this state compatible with technology used by
19	recording offices in other jurisdictions that enact
20	substantially the Uniform Real Property Electronic Recording
21	Act, the information technology commission and the state
22	commission of public records, in consultation with the county
23	clerks of New Mexico, so far as is consistent with the
24	purposes, policies and provisions of the Uniform Real
25	Property Electronic Recording Act, in adopting, amending and

repealing standards shall consider: 1 2 (1) standards and practices of other 3 jurisdictions; 4 (2) the most recent standards promulgated by 5 national standard-setting bodies, such as the property 6 records industry association; 7 (3) the views of interested persons and 8 governmental officials and entities; 9 (4) the needs of counties of varying size, 10 population and resources; and 11 (5) standards requiring adequate information 12 security protection to ensure that electronic documents are 13 accurate, authentic, adequately preserved and resistant to 14 tampering. 15 The secretary of state may adopt and promulgate C. 16 rules to implement the provisions of Subsection C of Section 17 14-9A-3 NMSA 1978 by providing for the electronic 18 notarization, acknowledgment, verification, swearing or 19 affirming under oath and other notarial acts by notaries 20 public with respect to a document or signature."_____ SB 209 Page 2 21 22 23 24 25
