6	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:		
7	Section 1. SHORT TITLEThis act may be cited as the		
8	"Sale of Recycled Metals Act".		
9	Section 2. DEFINITIONSAs used in the Sale of		
10	Recycled Metals Act:		
11	A. "aluminum material" means a product made from		
12	aluminum, an aluminum alloy or an aluminum byproduct.		
13	"Aluminum material" includes an aluminum beer keg but does		
14	not include other types of aluminum cans used to contain a		
15	food or beverage;		
16	B. "bronze material" means:		
17	(1) a cemetery vase, receptacle or memorial		
18	made from bronze;		
19	(2) bronze statuary; and		
20	(3) material readily identifiable as bronze;		
21	C. "business day" means any calendar day except		
22	Sunday or the following business holidays: New Year's day,		
23	Washington's birthday, Memorial day, Independence day, Labor		
24	day, Columbus day, Veterans' day, Thanksgiving day, Christmas		
25	day, Martin Luther King, Jr.'s birthday and any other legal	S.	

public holiday of the state of New Mexico or the United States;

3 D. "copper or brass material" means: (1) insulated or noninsulated copper wire, 4 5 hardware or cable of the type used by a public utility, commercial mobile radio service carrier or common carrier 6 that consists of at least twenty-five percent copper; and 7 8 (2) a copper or brass item of a type commonly used in construction or by a public utility, 9 commercial mobile radio service carrier or common carrier; 10 11 Ε. "department" means the regulation and licensing department; 12 "peace officer" means any full-time salaried 13 F. and commissioned or certified law enforcement officer of a 14 15 police or sheriff's department that is part of or administered by the state or any political subdivision of the 16 state; 17 G. "personal identification document" means: 18 (1) a driver's license; 19 20 (2) a military identification card; (3) a passport issued by the United States 21 or by another country and recognized by the United States; 22 and 23 a personal identification certificate 24 (4) issued by the department, or a corresponding card or 25

1 certificate issued by another state; 2 "regulated material" means: н. 3 (1) aluminum material; (2) bronze material; 4 5 (3) copper or brass material; and 6 (4) steel material; "secondhand metal dealer" means: 7 I. 8 (1) an auto wrecker, a scrap metal processor or other person that purchases, collects or solicits 9 10 regulated material; and 11 (2) a person who operates or maintains a scrap metal yard or other place in which scrap metal or 12 cast-off regulated material is collected or kept for 13 shipment, sale or transfer; 14 J. "steel material" means a product made from an 15 alloy of iron, chromium, nickel or manganese, including 16 stainless steel beer kegs; and 17 "superintendent" means the superintendent of Κ. 18 regulation and licensing. 19 20 Section 3. NOTICE TO SELLERS.--A. A secondhand metal dealer shall at all times 21 maintain in a prominent place in the dealer's place of 22 business, in open view to a seller of regulated material, a 23 notice in two-inch lettering that: 24 includes the following language: 25 (1) SJC/SB 281 Page 3

1 "A PERSON ATTEMPTING TO SELL REGULATED MATERIAL MUST 2 PRESENT SUFFICIENT IDENTIFICATION AS REQUIRED BY STATE LAW. 3 WARNING: STATE LAW PROVIDES A CIVIL FINE FOR A PERSON WHO INTENTIONALLY PROVIDES A FALSE DOCUMENT OF IDENTIFICATION 4 5 OR OTHER FALSE INFORMATION TO A SECONDHAND METAL DEALER WHILE ATTEMPTING TO SELL REGULATED MATERIAL."; and 6 7 (2) states the secondhand metal dealer's usual business hours. 8 The notice required by this section may be 9 Β. contained on a sign that contains another notice if the 10 secondhand metal dealer is required to display another notice 11 pursuant to applicable law. 12 Section 4. INFORMATION PROVIDED BY SELLER.--13 A. A person attempting to sell regulated material 14 15 to a secondhand metal dealer shall: (1)display to the secondhand metal dealer 16 the person's personal identification document; 17 sign a written statement provided by the 18 (2) secondhand metal dealer that the person is the legal owner of 19 20 or is lawfully entitled to sell the regulated material offered for sale; and 21 (3) provide to the secondhand metal dealer 22 the year, make, model and license plate number of the motor 23 vehicle used to transport the regulated material. 24 The secondhand metal dealer or the dealer's B. agent shall visually verify the accuracy of the personal 1 identification document and vehicle identification presented 2 3 by the seller at the time of the dealer's purchase of regulated material. 4 Section 5. RECORD OF PURCHASE .--5 A. A secondhand metal dealer in this state shall 6 keep an accurate and legible written record, in a form 7 8 approved by the department, of each purchase made in the course of the dealer's business from a person of: 9 10 (1) copper or brass material; (2) bronze material; 11 (3) aluminum material in excess of ten 12 pounds; or 13 (4) steel material in excess of one ton, 14 except that a written record shall be kept of each purchase 15 of a stainless steel beer keg. 16 The record shall be in English and shall Β. 17 include: 18 the place and date of the purchase; (1) 19 the name and address of each person from 20 (2) whom the regulated material is purchased or obtained; 21 the identifying number of the personal (3) 22 identification document of each person from whom the 23 regulated material is purchased or obtained; 24 (4) the year, make, model and license plate SJC/SB 281 25 Page 5

1 number of the motor vehicle used to transport the regulated 2 material;

3 (5) a description made in accordance with
4 the custom of the trade of the type and quantity of regulated
5 material purchased; and

(6) the statement required by Paragraph (2) of Subsection A of Section 4 of the Sale of Recycled Metals Act.

Section 6. PRESERVATION OF RECORDS.--A secondhand metal dealer shall preserve each record required by Section 5 of the Sale of Recycled Metals Act until the third anniversary of the date the record was made.

Section 7. INSPECTION OF RECORDS BY PEACE OFFICERS AND
 DEPARTMENT.--

A. Upon request, a secondhand metal dealer shall produce to a peace officer or an authorized employee of the department during the dealer's usual business hours the requested record of purchase as required by Section 5 of the Sale of Recycled Metals Act.

B. The inspecting peace officer or authorized
employee of the department shall inform the secondhand metal
dealer of the person's status as a peace officer or
authorized employee of the department.

24 Section 8. FURNISHING OF REPORT TO DEPARTMENT.--Not25 later than the second business day after the date of the

purchase or other acquisition of regulated material for which a record is required pursuant to Section 5 of the Sale of Recycled Metals Act, a secondhand metal dealer shall mail to or file with the department a report containing the information required to be recorded pursuant to that section.

Section 9. PUBLIC DATABASE.--The department shall establish and maintain an electronic database containing the records required to be preserved pursuant to Section 6 of the Sale of Recycled Metals Act, which database shall be accessible to the public. Records received by the department pursuant to Section 8 of the Sale of Recycled Metals Act shall be available in the database by the end of the second business day following receipt by the department.

Section 10. POWERS AND DUTIES OF SUPERINTENDENT.--The superintendent has authority to promulgate reasonable regulations for the administration and enforcement of the Sale of Recycled Metals Act and is expressly authorized to make regulations regarding records of purchase of regulated material and the public database required pursuant to that act.

Section 11. WAITING PERIOD FOR DISPOSAL OF REGULATED MATERIAL.--A secondhand metal dealer shall not process or permit to be removed from the dealer's premises regulated material until the fifth business day after the date on which the dealer acquired the regulated material.

Section 12. PROHIBITED ACTS.--A person shall not, with 1 2 the intent to deceive: 3 Α. display to a secondhand metal dealer a false or invalid personal identification document in connection with 4 the person's attempted sale of regulated material; or 5 B. make a false material statement or 6 representation to a secondhand metal dealer in connection 7 8 with: that person's execution of a written 9 (1)10 statement required by Subsection A of Section 4 of the Sale of Recycled Metals Act; or 11 (2) the dealer's efforts to obtain the 12 information required pursuant to Subsection B of Section 5 of 13 the Sale of Recycled Metals Act. 14 Section 13. CIVIL PENALTY .--15 A. A person who violates any provision of the Sale 16 of Recycled Metals Act may be assessed a civil penalty by the 17 superintendent not to exceed one thousand dollars (\$1,000) 18 per violation. 19 Prior to the imposition of a civil penalty, the 20 Β. person being penalized shall be afforded notice and an 21 opportunity to be heard by the superintendent pursuant to the 22 pertinent notice and hearing provisions of the Uniform 23 Licensing Act. 24 Section 14. SEVERABILITY.--If any part or application 25 SJC/SB 281 Page 8

1	of the Sale of Recycled Metals Act is held invalid, the	
2	remainder or its application to other situations or persons	
3	shall not be affected.	
4	Section 15. APPLICABILITYThe provisions of the Sale	
5	of Recycled Metals Act shall not apply to a purchase of	
6	regulated material from a manufacturing, industrial or other	
7	commercial vendor that sells regulated material in the	
8	ordinary course of the vendor's business.	
9	Section 16. EFFECTIVE DATEThe effective date of the	
10	provisions of this act is January 1, 2009
