10	a "new town" was established; and	
11	WHEREAS, Las Vegas was one of the largest cities in the	
12	southwest and it had its own opera house, a college, a Harvey	
13	House hotel and a Carnegie library; and	
14	WHEREAS, Las Vegas was host to a reunion of Teddy	
15	Roosevelt's rough riders, held the earliest recorded rodeo	
16	and was a venue for many colorful western characters and	
17	events; and	
18	WHEREAS, Las Vegas is a city rich in history and	
19	tradition;	
20	NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE	
21	STATE OF NEW MEXICO that January 30, 2008 be declared "Las
