#### **SUMMARY**

Synopsis of Bill

Senate Bill 457, Relating to Procurement; Increasing the Limits for Expenditures for Competitive Sealed Bids and for Small Business, raises the limit required for formal bids and advertisement for small purchase from \$20 thousand to \$30 thousand.

#### FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

The appropriation of \$0.0 thousand contained in this bill is a non-recurring expense to the general fund. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of FY09 shall revert to the general fund.

## **SIGNIFICANT ISSUES**

GSD notes that SB 457 eliminates the formal bid process, including public notice, for purchases of goods and non-professional services between \$20 thousand and \$30 thousand. (The limit for professional services, as defined in Section 13-1-76 of the Procurement Code, is \$50 thousand.)
