A JOINT MEMORIAL

DECLARING JANUARY 30, 2008 AS "FFA AND 4-H DAY" AT THE

WHEREAS, FFA and 4-H have been premier youth leadership  
organizations in New Mexico for more than eighty years; and

WHEREAS, FFA and 4-H sponsor chapters and clubs in rural  
and urban areas throughout the state; and

WHEREAS, over ninety thousand youth between the ages of  
five and twenty-one years old participate in FFA and 4-H youth  
development programs statewide; and

WHEREAS, FFA and 4-H youth development programs are  
diverse and help participants acquire important life skills,  
including leadership, responsible citizenship, critical  
thinking, problem-solving, decision-making, conflict resolution  
and communication skills, that directly contribute to the
