20	WHEREAS, New Mexico's community colleges, universities and
21	volunteer and community-based organizations provided more than
22	one million three hundred thousand instructional hours of basic
23	skills and literacy services to more than thirty thousand
24	adults during the 2006-2007 program year, with the result that
