NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the economic development department and the taxation and revenue department be requested to examine the effectiveness of current tax incentives and other incentives to attract and retain manufacturing operations to the state; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that, in conducting this examination, these departments be requested to consult with representatives of current manufacturing operations in the state, members of the general business community, tax policy experts, economists and local government officials; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that these departments be requested to report the results of their examination and their recommendations for any new legislation to the legislative finance committee and the interim revenue stabilization and tax .172300.1 -2-
