WHEREAS, science-based research has shown that a young person who is matched with a big brother or big sister volunteer is:

5 A. forty-six percent less likely to start using
6 illegal drugs;

B. twenty-seven percent less likely to start drinking;

9 C. fifty-two percent less likely to skip a day of10 school;

11 D. thirty-seven percent less likely to skip a 12 class; and

E. less likely to engage in violence; and WHEREAS, the positive impact of big brothers big sisters has proved that one adult caring for one child is the most powerful force to keep young people in school, off drugs and alcohol and out of trouble with the law; and

WHEREAS, New Mexico's big brothers big sisters programs and its school-based partners have grown twice as fast as the national average, increasing the number of youth matched with adults by nearly sixty percent to three thousand one hundred big-little matches in the past year; and

WHEREAS, with waiting lists for all of its programs and a torrent of requests from unserved counties in New Mexico, the big brothers big sisters programs in New Mexico are committed .172377.1
