## A CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

ADOPTING A LEGISLATIVE JOINT RULE LIMITING THE NUMBER OF BILLS INTRODUCED BY EACH MEMBER.

WHEREAS, Legislative Joint Rule 8-1 requires that joint rules may be adopted, amended or repealed by concurrent resolution approved by two-thirds of the membership of each house:

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE, THE HOUSE OF REPRESENTATIVES CONCURRING THEREIN, that the following new joint rule be adopted to read:

"LIMITATION ON NUMBER OF BILLS INTRODUCED BY A LEGISLATOR

- No member shall introduce more than fifteen Α. bills during a legislative session.
  - Excluded from each legislator's total are:
