17	BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
18	Section l. It is proposed to amend Article 4 of the
19	constitution of New Mexico by adding a new section to read:
20	"The legislature may, by law, prohibit regulatory rules
21	proposed by an agency or officer of the executive branch from
22	taking effect until the proposed rules have been reviewed and
23	approved by the appropriate interim or standing committees of
24	the legislature. The law may establish procedures for
25	selecting those rules subject to the review and approval of
