10 AN ACT

11 RELATING TO DISASTERS; PROVIDING FOR RESPONSES TO FLOOD DAMAGE  
12 IN LINCOLN AND OTERO COUNTIES; MAKING APPROPRIATIONS; DECLARING  
13 AN EMERGENCY.

15 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

16 Section 1. APPROPRIATIONS.--

17 A. Five million dollars (\$5,000,000) is  
18 appropriated from the general fund to the department of  
19 transportation for expenditure in fiscal years 2009 through  
20 2013 to plan, design and construct improvements to roads and  
21 bridges damaged by severe flooding in Lincoln and Otero  
22 counties. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at  
23 the end of fiscal year 2013 shall revert to the general fund.

24 B. One hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) is  
25 appropriated from the general fund to the homeland security and

1 emergency management department for expenditure in fiscal years  
2 2009 and 2010 for emergency relief for flood victims along the  
3 Rio Ruidoso as provided in Section 12-11-25 NMSA 1978. Any  
4 unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of  
5 fiscal year 2010 shall revert to the general fund.

6 Section 2. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public  
7 peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
