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16	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
17	Section 1. A new section of the General Appropriation Act
18	of 2008 is enacted to read:
19	"[<u>NEW MATERIAL</u>] APPROPRIATION REDUCTIONS
20	A. Except as provided in Subsections B through G of
21	this section, all amounts set out under the general fund column
22	in Section 4 of the General Appropriation Act of 2008 are
23	reduced by two and one-half percent rounded to the nearest one
24	hundred dollars (\$100).
25	B. In lieu of the reduction made in Subsection A of
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1 this section and except as provided in Subsection G of this
2 section, the general fund appropriations in Section 4 of the
3 General Appropriation Act of 2008 to the following agencies are
4 reduced by the specified percentage, rounded to the nearest one
5 hundred dollars (\$100):

6 (1) the personnel board, the public employee
7 labor relations board, the regulation and licensing department,
8 the energy, minerals and natural resources department, the
9 state engineer and the department of environment are reduced by
10 five percent;

(2) the economic development department is reduced by three and nine-tenths percent;

(3) the public education department is reducedby three and eight-tenths percent;

15 (4) the taxation and revenue department, the
16 cultural affairs department and the aging and long-term
17 services department are reduced by three percent;

(5) the veterans' services department is reduced by two and four-tenths percent;

(6) the workforce solutions department is reduced by two and one-tenth percent;

(7) the district attorneys, the administrative office of the district attorneys, the public defender department, the children, youth and families department, the corrections department and the department of public safety are .175815.2

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1 reduced by one and nine-tenths percent; 2 the vocational rehabilitation division is (8) 3 reduced by one and eight-tenths percent; 4 (9) the developmental disabilities planning 5 council is reduced by one and six-tenths percent; 6 (10) the supreme court law library, the New 7 Mexico compilation commission, the judicial standards 8 commission, the court of appeals, the supreme court, the 9 administrative office of the courts, the supreme court building 10 commission, the district courts and the Bernalillo county 11 metropolitan court are reduced by one and four-tenths percent; 12 and 13 the appropriation to the lieutenant (11)14 governor is not reduced. 15 In lieu of the reduction made in Subsection A of C. 16 this section, the general fund appropriations in Section 4 of 17 the General Appropriation Act of 2008 to the medical assistance 18 program of the human services department and the medicaid 19 behavioral health program of the human services department are 20 reduced by one percent rounded to the nearest one hundred 21 dollars (\$100).

D. After the reduction pursuant to Subsection C of this section, the general fund appropriation in Section 4 of the General Appropriation Act of 2008 to the medical assistance program of the human services department in the other category .175815.2

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is further reduced by twenty-four million five hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$24,550,000).

E. After the reduction pursuant to Subsection A of this section, the general fund appropriation in Section 4 of the General Appropriation Act of 2008 to the transportation distribution for public schools is further reduced by four million dollars (\$4,000,000).

F. After the reductions pursuant to Subsections A through E of this section, the total appropriation from the general fund to each agency and institution in Section 4 of the General Appropriation Act of 2008 is further reduced by an amount equal to two and one-half percent of that agency's or institution's allocation of the compensation appropriation made in Section 8 of that act. The reductions shall be made using the same methodology used by the department of finance and administration and the higher education department in allocating the compensation appropriation. Each agency and institution shall use program transfers, category transfers, cash balances, vacancy savings and other available funds to provide the increases provided for in Section 8 of the General Appropriation Act of 2008 and Laws 2008, Chapter 6, Section 43.

G. A reduction to an appropriation, otherwise required by Subsection A or B of this section, shall not be made if the state budget division of the department of finance and administration determines that:

The 5 authority granted by this subsection is in addition to the 6 budget adjustment authority granted in Section 10 of the 7 General Appropriation Act of 2008; and 8 B. a program with internal service 9 funds/interagency transfers appropriations or other state funds 10 appropriations that collects money in excess of the amounts 11 appropriated may request budget increases in an amount not to 12 exceed five percent of its internal funds/interagency transfers 13 or other state funds appropriations contained in Section 4 of 14 the General Appropriation Act of 2008. Section 3. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.

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
