FOR THE ECONOMIC AND RURAL DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE

RELATING TO HIGHER EDUCATION; PROHIBITING POST-SECONDARY
EDUCATIONAL INSTITUTIONS IN NEW MEXICO FROM SELLING STUDENT
LISTS TO FINANCIAL INSTITUTIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. SALE OF STUDENT INFORMATION--MARKETING CREDIT
CARDS TO STUDENTS--PROHIBITED PRACTICES.--

A. No public or private post-secondary educational institution, including its agents, its employees, its student or alumni organizations or its affiliates, shall:

(1) sell, give or otherwise transfer to any card issuer the name, address, telephone number or other contact information of an undergraduate student at the post-secondary educational institution without the student's consent; or
