Section 1. A new section of the School Personnel Act is enacted to read:

"[NEW MATERIAL] LICENSURE ADVANCEMENT--PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT DOSSIER. --

- The department shall prescribe the scope and content of a professional development dossier as an accurate reflection of a teacher's classroom performance and as a requirement for advancement to a level two or level three-A license.
