20	A. A person shall not operate an off-highway motor
21	vehicle on [any:
22	(1)] <u>a</u> limited access highway or freeway at any

24	(2) any paved street or highway except as
25	provided in Subsection B of this section.

1	B. Off-highway motor vehicles may cross streets or
2	highways, except limited access highways or freeways, if the
3	crossings are made after coming to a complete stop prior to
4	entering the roadway. Off-highway motor vehicles shall yield
5	the right of way to oncoming traffic and shall begin a crossing
6	only when it can be executed safely and then cross in the most
7	direct manner as close to a perpendicular angle as possible.
8	C.] B. A person shall not operate an off-highway
9	motor vehicle on state game commission-owned, -controlled or
10	-administered land except as specifically allowed pursuant to
11	Chapter 17, Article 6 NMSA 1978.
12	$[D_{\bullet}]$ <u>C.</u> A person shall not operate an off-highway
13	motor vehicle on land owned, controlled or administered by the
14	state parks division of the energy, minerals and natural
15	resources department, pursuant to Chapter 16, Article 2 NMSA
16	1978, except in areas designated by and permitted by rules
17	adopted by the secretary of energy, minerals and natural
