BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. APPROPRIATION. --

Two million nine hundred forty-six thousand dollars (\$2,946,000) is appropriated from the general fund for expenditure in fiscal year 2010 to fund various health-related services as follows:

(1) two million dollars (\$2,000,000) to the department of information technology for the required matching funds for a federal communications commission allocation to New Mexico of eleven million three hundred thousand dollars (\$11,300,000) to be administered in collaboration with the university of New Mexico center for telehealth to design, create and implement a rural health telemedicine network

throughout New Mexico;

(\$150,000) to the department of health to contract with a nonprofit organization to continue implementation of a health information exchange collaborative network to serve rural and underserved communities in New Mexico and to enhance the capacity of existing telehealth services;

- (3) seven hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$750,000) to the children, youth and families department to expand the home visiting program; and
- (4) forty-six thousand dollars (\$46,000) to the birthing workforce retention fund to provide malpractice insurance premium assistance for certified nurse-midwives or physicians whose insurance premium costs jeopardize their ability to continue their obstetric practices in New Mexico.
- B. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance remaining at the end of fiscal year 2010 shall revert to the general fund.
