18	Section 1. Section 27-2E-1 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2003,
19	Chapter 381, Section 1) is amended to read:
20	"27-2E-1. AVERAGE MANUFACTURER PRICEFILING
21	REPORTING
22	A. A person who manufactures a prescription drug,
23	including a generic prescription drug, that is sold in New
24	Mexico shall file with the human services department:
25	(1) the average manufacturer price for the
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drug;

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2 (2) the price that each wholesaler or pharmacy 3 benefit manager doing business in this state pays the 4 manufacturer to purchase the drug; and 5 the price paid to the manufacturer by any (3) 6 entity in an arrangement or contract that sells or provides 7 prescription drugs in New Mexico without the services of a 8 wholesaler. 9 Β. The information required under Subsection A of 10 this section shall be filed annually or more frequently, as 11 determined by the human services department. The information 12 required under Subsection A of this section is confidential and 13 shall not be disclosed pursuant to Section [3 of this act] 14 <u>27-2E-2 NMSA 1978</u> and shall not be subject to public inspection 15 pursuant to the provisions of Section 14-2-1 NMSA 1978. 16 C. A person who engages in the wholesale 17 distribution of prescription drugs in New Mexico shall file 18 with the human services department information showing the 19 actual price at which the wholesaler or distributor sells a 20 particular drug to a pharmacy. 21 D. The human services department shall report to 22 the interim legislative health and human services committee on 23 the information it receives pursuant to this section by

November 1 of each year.

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1 manufacturer price" means the average price paid to the 2 manufacturer for the drug in New Mexico, including rebates, 3 discounts and market incentives, after deducting customary prompt-pay discounts." 4 Section 2. 6	or both, [together with] and assessed costs of prosecution, and
7	shall not be employed by the state for a period of five years
8	after the date of the conviction."
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
