 - 4. Reletter the succeeding subsection accordingly.
 - 5. On page 4, line 19, strike the comma.
- 6. On page 4, line 20, strike "investigating and responding to" and insert in lieu thereof "and maintaining a record of".
 - 7. On page 4, line 21, after the period insert:

"The attorney general may initiate an investigation of a complaint alleging profiling and take necessary action as the attorney general deems appropriate.".,
