15	Section 1. INDIAN ARTS AND CRAFTS FUNDCREATED
16	PURPOSEAPPROPRIATIONThe "Indian arts and crafts fund" is
17	created as a nonreverting fund in the state treasury and shall
18	be administered by the cultural affairs department. The
19	department shall establish procedures and adopt rules as
20	required to administer the fund. The fund shall consist of
21	appropriations, grants, donations and money that otherwise
22	accrues to the fund. Income from investment of the fund shall
23	be credited to the fund. Money in the fund shall be
24	appropriated by the legislature to the cultural affairs
25	department to conduct studies regarding Native American arts

1 and crafts, including the extent to which the manufacture and 2 sale of Native American arts and crafts contribute to the state's culture and economy, the potential adverse impact of 3 4 the import, production and sale of items of non-authentic 5 Native American arts and crafts, the extent to which nonauthentic Native American arts and crafts are misrepresented to 6 7 the public and ways in which the state might promote and 8 protect the contribution of the manufacture and sale of Native 9 American arts and crafts to the state's economy. Money shall 10 be disbursed from the fund only on warrant of the secretary of 11 finance and administration upon vouchers signed by the 12 secretary of cultural affairs or the secretary's authorized 13 representative. Any unexpended or unencumbered balance 14 remaining at the end of a fiscal year shall not revert to the 15 general fund.
