AN ACT

RELATING TO PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT; AMENDING THE PUBLIC EMPLOYEES RETIREMENT ACT TO CHANGE THE RETIREMENT ELIGIBILITY FOR NEW MEMBERS; RECONCILING MULTIPLE AMENDMENTS TO THE SAME SECTION OF LAW IN LAWS 2003.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

- B. The increased credited service provided in

 Subsection A of this section may be used only for the purposes

 of state police member and adult correctional officer member

 coverage plan 1, and, if a member transfers or otherwise

 becomes subject to another coverage plan, only the actual

 credited service, rather than the increased credited service,

 may be used to determine retirement eligibility under that

 other plan.
- [8.] C. State police member and adult correctional officer member coverage plan 1 is applicable to adult
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correctional officer members in the first full pay period after July 1, 2004 if the retirement board certifies to the secretary of state that, of those adult correctional officer members to be covered under state police member and adult correctional officer member coverage plan 1, a majority of the members voting have voted to approve adoption of that plan at an election conducted pursuant to [Section 16 of this 2003 act] Laws 2003, Chapter 268, Section 16."

- B. In calculating credited service for the purposes of determining retirement eligibility and amount of pension, the credited service of a municipal detention officer member who was a retired member or a member on June 30, 2009 shall have actual credited service increased by twenty percent only for the purposes of municipal detention officer member coverage plan 1, and, if a member transfers or otherwise becomes subject to another coverage plan, only the actual credited service, rather than the increased credited service, may be used to determine retirement eligibility under that other plan."

Section 14. EFFECTIVE DATE.--The effective date of the provisions of this act is July 1, 2009.

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
