- (2) the number of full-time employees at that agency on November 15, 2008, the effective date of the governor's hiring freeze.
- Except as provided in Subsection C of this section, notwithstanding the provisions of any other law enacted by the first session of the forty-ninth legislature, no reduction in any fiscal year 2009 program appropriation to any agency shall take effect until that agency is in compliance with the requirement of Subsection A of this section.
- The prohibition of Subsection B of this section shall not apply to reductions made by the first session of the forty-ninth legislature in appropriations to the personal services and employee benefits category of a program.
- Fiscal year 2009 appropriation reductions made D. in other laws enacted by the first session of the forty-ninth legislature shall be adjusted by the state budget division of the department of finance and administration to reflect savings realized by compliance with the provisions of this section.
- EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public Section 2. peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
