11 MAKING AN APPROPRIATION FOR AN AFTER-SCHOOL PROGRAM THAT USES
12 COLLABORATIVE PARTNERSHIPS WITHIN THE COMMUNITY TO COORDINATE
13 AND PROVIDE ASSISTANCE TO STUDENTS AND SCHOOLS TO MAKE ADEQUATE
14 YEARLY PROGRESS IN TAOS COUNTY.

16 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

17 Section 1. APPROPRIATION.--One hundred twenty-eight
18 thousand dollars (\$128,000) is appropriated from the general
19 fund to the local government division of the department of
20 finance and administration for expenditure in fiscal year 2010
21 for the town of Taos, through collaborative partnerships, to
22 coordinate and provide after-school programs that use academic
23 support, integrated learning experiences and support services
24 to assist students and schools in Taos county to improve
25 academic performance in order to make adequate yearly progress
