The institute shall offer at least the following 3 programs: 4 (1) licensure preparation for aspiring 5 principals; mentoring for new principals and other 6 (2) 7 public school leaders; 8 (3) intensive support for principals at 9 schools in need of improvement; 10 (4) professional development for aspiring 11 superintendents; and 12 mentoring for new superintendents. (5) 13 С. The institute shall partner with state agencies, 14 institutions of higher education and professional associations 15 to identify and recruit candidates for the institute." 16 Section 2. APPROPRIATION. -- Two hundred thousand dollars 17 (\$200,000) is appropriated from the appropriation contingency 18 fund of the general fund to the higher education department for 19 expenditure in fiscal years 2009 and 2010 to establish the 20 school leadership institute and provide for salaries and 21 benefits for up to three full-time-equivalent positions.
