AN ACT

RELATING TO EDUCATION; EXPANDING THE AUTHORITY OF THE
LEGISLATIVE EDUCATION STUDY COMMITTEE TO STUDY HIGHER EDUCATION
AS PART OF THE ENTIRETY OF EDUCATION IN NEW MEXICO.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 2-10-3 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1971,
Chapter 287, Section 3, as amended) is amended to read:

"2-10-3. DUTIES OF THE LEGISLATIVE EDUCATION STUDY
COMMITTEE.--The legislative education study committee shall:

A. direct the director in [~~his~~] the work [~~for~~] of
the committee;

B. conduct a continuing study of all education in
New Mexico, the laws governing such education and the policies
and costs of the New Mexico educational system [~~provided that~~
~~such studies shall not duplicate studies conducted by the board~~
