16	Section 1. Section 2-8D-4 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2002,

19	A. Members of the senate shall be elected for terms
20	of four years.
21	B. If a vacancy occurs in the office of senator for
22	any reason, the vacancy shall be filled as follows:
23	(1) for a senate district that is situated

1 senator to fill the vacancy; and 2 (2) for a senate district situated within two 3 or more counties: 4 the board of county commissioners of (a) 5 each county in the senate district shall submit one name to the 6 governor, provided, however, that if a board of county 7 commissioners submits the name of a member of that board, the 8 board shall submit at least one additional name of a person who 9 is not a member of that board; and 10 (b) the governor shall appoint the 11 senator to fill the vacancy from the list of names so 12 submitted. 13 An appointment to fill a vacancy in the senate C. 14 shall be for a term ending on December 31 after the next 15 general election. 16 An appointment to fill a vacancy made before the D. 17 general election of 2004 shall be made from the district as it 18 was described in Laws 1991 (1st S.S.), Chapter 3, Sections 7 19 through 48. After the general election of 2004, a vacancy 20 shall be filled by appointment from the district set out in the 21 2002 Senate Redistricting Act." 22 Section 2.
