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19	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
20	Section 1. SEVERANCE TAX BONDSAUTHORIZATIONS
21	APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS
22	A. The state board of finance may issue and sell
23	severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax
24	Bonding Act in an amount not to exceed the total of the amounts
25	authorized for purposes specified in this act. The state board
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of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner possible upon a finding by the board that the project has been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time. The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended. Proceeds from the sale of the bonds are appropriated for the purposes specified in this act.

B. The agencies named in this act shall certify to the state board of finance when the money from the proceeds of the severance tax bonds authorized in this section is needed for the purposes specified in the applicable section of this act. If an agency has not certified the need for the issuance of the bonds for a particular project, including projects that have been reauthorized, by the end of fiscal year 2011, the authorization for that project is void.

C. Before an agency may certify for the issuance of severance tax bonds, the project must be developed sufficiently so that the agency reasonably expects to:

(1) incur within six months after the applicable bonds have been issued a substantial binding obligation to a third party to expend at least five percent of the bond proceeds for the project; and

(2) spend at least eighty-five percent of the.175946.1

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1 bond proceeds within three years after the applicable bonds 2 have been issued. 3 Except as otherwise specifically provided by D. 4 law: 5 the unexpended balance from the proceeds (1)6 of severance tax bonds issued pursuant to this act for a 7 project shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund no later 8 than the following dates: 9 (a) for a project for which severance 10 tax bonds were issued to match federal grants, six months after 11 completion of the project; 12 (b) for a project for which severance 13 tax bonds were issued to purchase vehicles, including emergency 14 vehicles and other vehicles that require special equipment; 15 heavy equipment; books; educational technology; or other 16 equipment or furniture that is not related to a more inclusive 17 construction or renovation project, at the end of the fiscal 18 year two years following the fiscal year in which the severance 19 tax bonds were issued for the purchase; and 20 for any other project for which (c) 21 severance tax bonds were issued, within six months of 22 completion of the project, but no later than the end of fiscal 23 year 2013; and 24 (2) all remaining balances from the proceeds 25 of severance tax bonds issued for a project pursuant to this

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act shall revert to the severance tax bonding fund three months after the latest reversion date specified for that type of project in Paragraph (1) of this subsection, whether or not any of the remaining balances are subject to a contractual obligation to third parties.

E. Except for appropriations to the capital program fund, money from severance tax bond proceeds provided pursuant to this act shall not be used to pay indirect project costs.

9 F. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended
10 balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after
11 reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding
12 written obligations to third parties.

Section 2. GENERAL FUND AND OTHER FUND APPROPRIATIONS--LIMITATIONS--REVERSIONS.--

A. Except as otherwise specifically provided by law:

(1) the unexpended balance of an appropriation made in this act from the general fund or other state fund shall revert no later than the following dates:

(a) for a project for which anappropriation was made to match federal grants, six monthsafter completion of the project;

(b) for a project for which an appropriation was made to purchase vehicles, including emergency vehicles and other vehicles that require special .175946.1

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equipment; heavy equipment; books; educational technology; or other equipment or furniture that is not related to a more inclusive construction or renovation project, at the end of the fiscal year two years following the fiscal year in which the appropriation was made for the purchase; and

(c) for any other project for which an appropriation was made, within six months of completion of the project, but no later than the end of fiscal year 2013; and

(2) all remaining balances from an appropriation made in this act for a project shall revert three months after the latest reversion date specified for that type of project in Paragraph (1) of this subsection, whether or not any of the remaining balances are subject to a contractual obligation to third parties.

B. Upon certification by an agency that money from the general fund is needed for a purpose specified in this act, the secretary of finance and administration shall disburse such amount of the appropriation for that project as is necessary to meet that need.

C. Except for appropriations to the capital program fund, money from appropriations made in this act shall not be used to pay indirect project costs.

D. Except as provided in Subsection F of this section, the balance of an appropriation made from the general fund shall revert in the time frame set forth in Subsection A .175946.1

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of this section to the capital projects fund.

E. Except as provided in Subsection F of this section, the balance of an appropriation made from other state funds shall revert in the time frame set forth in Subsection A of this section to the originating fund.

F. The balance of an appropriation made from the general fund or other state fund to the Indian affairs department or the aging and long-term services department for a project located on lands of an Indian nation, tribe or pueblo shall revert in the time frame set forth in Subsection A of this section to the tribal infrastructure project fund.

G. For the purpose of this section, "unexpended balance" means the remainder of an appropriation after reserving for unpaid costs and expenses covered by binding written obligations to third parties.

Section 3. PUBLIC EDUCATION DEPARTMENT PROJECT--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 of this act, upon certification by the public education department that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, four hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$450,000) is appropriated to the public education department to plan, design, construct and improve a synthetic turf field at Roosevelt middle school in the Albuquerque public school district in Bernalillo county.

Section 4. DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION PROJECT--SEVERANCE TAX BONDS.--Pursuant to the provisions of Section 1 .175946.1

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of this act, upon certification by the department of transportation that the need exists for the issuance of the bonds, two hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$250,000) is appropriated to the department of transportation to plan, design and construct sidewalks on Lisbon street from Southern boulevard to Tarpon road to Southern boulevard in Rio Rancho in Sandoval county.

Section 5. AGING AND LONG-TERM SERVICES DEPARTMENT PROJECTS--GENERAL FUND.--The following amounts are appropriated from the general fund to the aging and long-term services department for expenditure in fiscal years 2009 through 2013, unless otherwise provided in Section 2 of this act, for the following purposes:

1. twenty thousand dollars (\$20,000) to purchase and install equipment, including shelving, storage units and a quilting machine, for the Whispering Pines senior meal site in Bernalillo county; and

2. forty thousand dollars (\$40,000) to plan, design and construct a senior center at the Counselor chapter of the Navajo Nation in Sandoval county.

Section 6. CHILDREN, YOUTH AND FAMILIES DEPARTMENT PROJECT--GENERAL FUND.--Four thousand dollars (\$4,000) is appropriated from the general fund to the children, youth and families department for expenditure in fiscal years 2009 through 2013, unless otherwise provided in Section 2 of this .175946.1

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act, to purchase and install information technology, including related equipment, furniture and infrastructure, for a program to promote family education and engagement for the children, youth and families department in Albuquerque in Bernalillo county.

Section 7. CULTURAL AFFAIRS DEPARTMENT PROJECTS--GENERAL FUND.--The following amounts are appropriated from the general fund to the cultural affairs department for expenditure in fiscal years 2009 through 2013, unless otherwise provided in Section 2 of this act, for the following purposes:

Section 10. Section 28. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.

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
