16	Section 1. Section 66-5-9 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1978,
17	Chapter 35, Section 231, as amended) is amended to read:
18	"66-5-9. APPLICATION FOR LICENSE, TEMPORARY LICENSE,
19	PROVISIONAL LICENSE OR INSTRUCTION PERMIT
20	A. An application for an instruction permit,
21	provisional license or driver's license shall be made upon a
22	form furnished by the department. An application shall be
23	accompanied by the proper fee. For permits, provisional
24	licenses or driver's licenses other than those issued pursuant
25	to the New Mexico Commercial Driver's License Act, submission

<u>underscored material = new</u> [bracketed material] = delete of a complete application with payment of the fee entitles the applicant to not more than three attempts to pass the examination within a period of six months from the date of application.

An application shall contain the full name, Β. social security number or individual tax identification number, 7 date of birth, sex, [and] New Mexico residence address of the 8 applicant and mailing address of the applicant, if different from the New Mexico residence address. The application shall 10 briefly describe the applicant and indicate whether the applicant has previously been licensed as a driver and, if so, 12 when and by what state or country and whether any such license has ever been suspended or revoked or whether an application has ever been refused and, if so, the date of and reason for the suspension, revocation or refusal. For foreign nationals applying for driver's licenses, the secretary shall accept the individual taxpayer identification number as a substitute for a social security number regardless of immigration status. The secretary is authorized to establish by regulation other documents that may be accepted as a substitute for a social security number or an individual tax identification number.

An applicant shall indicate whether [he] the C. applicant has been convicted of driving while under the influence of intoxicating liquor or drugs in this state or in any other jurisdiction. Failure to disclose any such .176116.1

1 conviction prevents the issuance of a driver's license, 2 provisional license, temporary license or instruction permit 3 for a period of one year if the failure to disclose is 4 discovered by the department prior to issuance. If the 5 nondisclosure is discovered by the department subsequent to 6 issuance, the department shall revoke the driver's license, 7 provisional license, temporary license or instruction permit 8 for a period of one year. Intentional and willful failure to 9 disclose, as required in this subsection, is a misdemeanor.

D. An applicant [<del>less than</del>] <u>who is under</u> eighteen years of age <u>and</u> who is making an application to be granted [<u>his</u>] <u>a</u> first New Mexico driver's license shall submit evidence that [<del>he</del>] <u>the applicant</u> has:

(1) successfully completed a driver education course that included a DWI prevention and education program approved by the bureau or offered by a public school. The bureau may accept verification of driver education course completion from another state if the driver education course substantially meets the requirements of the bureau for a course offered in New Mexico;

(2) had a provisional license for the twelvemonth period immediately preceding the date of the application for the driver's license;
