18	"21-19-13. DISTRIBUTIONS OF DEVELOPMENT TRAINING FUNDS
19	A. Of appropriations made in any fiscal year for
20	development training, up to two-thirds shall be expended in
21	urban communities in the state. At least one-third of the
22	appropriations made in any fiscal year for development training
23	shall be expended in nonurban communities.
24	B. Of money available in the development training
25	fund, the economic development department may use in any fiscal

2	(1) up to fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000) to

13	D. At least twenty-five percent of the money
14	disbursed annually from the development training program shall
15	be dedicated to development training in energy exporting
16	industries.

19	that is not an urban community or is the unincorporated area of
