19	A. The director of the department of game and fish
20	shall issue without a fee a general hunting and fishing license
21	and class A trout stamp to any resident who was [ <del>one hundred</del>
22	percent] disabled as a result of having served in the armed
23	forces of the United States, upon submission by the person of
24	proof satisfactory to the commission that [ <del>he</del> ] <u>the person</u> was
25	[one hundred percent] disabled as a result of having served in

2	B. Any license and stamp issued pursuant to the
3	provisions of Subsection A of this section shall be issued only
4	once, but shall be issued for the life of the licensee,
5	provided the licensee is a resident of New Mexico and provided
6	the licensee notifies the director of the department of game
7	and fish promptly of any change of residence within or outside
8	the state.
9	C. Any person holding a license and stamp under the
10	provisions of this section shall be subject to all applicable
11	hunting and fishing regulations, provisions and penalties of
12	Chapter 17 NMSA 1978."

14	provisions of this act is July 1, 2009.
