14	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
15	Section 1. STANDARD TIMEDEFINITIONOBSERVANCE
16	A. The standard time of New Mexico is standard time
17	based on the mean solar time of the one hundred fifth degree of
18	longitude west of Greenwich, commonly known as mountain
19	standard time.
20	B. New Mexico hereby exempts itself from the
21	provisions of Subsection (a) of 15 USCA Section 260 providing
22	for the advancement of time. The entire state, including all
23	of its political subdivisions, shall throughout the year
24	observe standard time as defined in Subsection A of this
25	section.
