AN ACT

RELATING TO THE PUBLIC PEACE, HEALTH, SAFETY AND WELFARE;
PROVIDING RESIDENT TUITION FOR COLLEGE OF SANTA FE STUDENTS WHO
TRANSER TO STATE BACCALAUREATE-GRANTING EDUCATIONAL
INSTITUTIONS; PROVIDING FOR TRANSFER OF CREDITS; ALLOWING
LEGISLATIVE LOTTERY SCHOLARSHIPS FOR NEW MEXICO RESIDENT
STUDENTS WHO OTHERWISE QUALIFY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. TEMPORARY PROVISION--COLLEGE OF SANTA FE
STUDENTS RECEIVE RESIDENT TUITION--TRANSFER OF CREDITS-LEGISLATIVE LOTTERY SCHOLARSHIP.--

A. Notwithstanding any other provision of law, any state baccalaureate-granting post-secondary educational institution shall allow a student who was enrolled at the college of Santa Fe during the 2008-2009 school year to enroll .178866.1

in the institution and pay resident tuition rates for no more than three consecutive years as determined by the higher education department.

- B. The higher education department shall establish a plan to facilitate the transfer of credits and students between the college of Santa Fe and the state baccalaureategranting post-secondary educational institutions. Each institution shall accept for transfer those credits earned by a student while enrolled at the college of Santa Fe if they meet the requirements of the institution's degree-granting programs.
- C. A New Mexico high school graduate who would have met the requirements for a legislative lottery scholarship but who chose to attend the college of Santa Fe may receive a scholarship for no more than three consecutive years as long as the student complies with the requirements for the scholarship.
