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15	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:
16	Section 1. STATE AGENCY ACCOUNTABILITY
17	A. For applications for a license received after
18	January 1, 2010, state agencies shall provide each applicant
19	with a specific time frame for the agency's response to the
20	application at the time that the applicant submits the
21	application.
22	B. No later than December 31, 2009, each state
23	agency shall promulgate rules establishing specific time frames
24	for response to license applications. In promulgating rules
25	pursuant to this subsection, agencies may provide for a mutual
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1	extension of any deadline for licensing, and they shall
2	consider:
3	(1) the complexity of the licensing process
4	for each type of license; and
5	(2) the economic impact on the applicant or on
6	any other person or community that is likely to result from a
7	delay in issuance of a license.
8	C. For the purposes of this section:
9	(1) "license" includes the whole or part of
10	any permit, certificate, approval, registration, charter,
11	membership, statutory exemption or other form of permission
12	required by law;
13	(2) "licensing" includes the agency process
14	respecting the granting, denial, renewal, revocation,
15	suspension, annulment, withdrawal, amendment, limiting,
16	modifying or conditioning of a license; and
17	(3) "state agency" means any state agency,
18	board, commission, department or officer authorized by law to
19	make rules or grant licenses in the executive branch of state
20	government.
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
