I request that the following be funded:

SANTA TERESA RAILROAD CROSSING PLAN & INFRA

one million dollars (\$1,000,000) for a feasibility study, including related requirements, for a railroad crossing into Mexico at Santa Teresa, an extension of railroad infrastructure to the border and permitting in Dona Ana county

BORDER DEVELOPMENT PLAN-INFRA & ECON DEVELOPMENT

three hundred thousand dollars (\$300,000) for a development plan along New Mexico's border with Mexico, including the impact on economic development, border crossings and transportation, utility and service infrastructure

one million eight hundred thousand dollars (\$1,800,000) to plan, design, construct and equip a sports complex in Sunland Park in Dona Ana county
