AN ACT

RELATING TO PROFESSIONAL LICENSING; AMENDING A QUALIFICATION FOR LICENSURE AS A NAPRAPATH.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. Section 61-12E-5 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2003, Chapter 60, Section 5) is amended to read:

"61-12E-5. EDUCATION--PROFESSIONAL QUALIFICATIONS.--

A. A person shall be licensed as a naprapath if that person:

- (1) is at least twenty-one years of age;
- (2) has graduated from a two-year collegelevel program or an equivalent program approved by the superintendent after consultation with the board;
- years, a four-year academic curriculum in naprapathy, that is approved by the board, and the person has successfully completed one hundred thirty-two hours of academic credit, including sixty-six credit hours in basic science courses with emphasis on the study of connective tissue, and sixty-six credit hours in clinical naprapathic science, theory and application;
- (4) has passed the national board of naprapathic examiners examination or holds a valid license as a naprapath in another jurisdiction; and

- B. The superintendent or the board may require a personal interview with an applicant to evaluate that person's qualifications for a license."
