1 AN ACT 2 RELATING TO THE ENVIRONMENT; ENACTING A NEW SECTION OF THE 3 ENVIRONMENTAL IMPROVEMENT ACT TO PROVIDE FOR ASSISTANCE TO INDIGENT PERSONS TO REPLACE SUBSTANDARD LIQUID WASTE DISPOSAL 4 5 SYSTEMS; CREATING A FUND; PROVIDING FOR DISTRIBUTIONS; MAKING 6 AN APPROPRIATION. 7 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO: 8 Section 1. A new section of the Environmental 9 Improvement Act is enacted to read: 10 "LIQUID WASTE DISPOSAL SYSTEM ASSISTANCE FUND--11 CREATED--PURPOSE .--12 The "liquid waste disposal system assistance 13 Α. fund" is created in the state treasury. The department shall 14 15 administer the fund. The fund may be composed of appropriations and transfers of money earned from investment 16 of the fund and otherwise accruing to the fund and transfers 17 of money from the liquid waste fund not to exceed two hundred 18 thousand dollars (\$200,000) from the unexpended balance in 19 20 the fund. Balances remaining in the fund at the end of a fiscal year shall remain to the credit of the fund. 21 Disbursements from the fund shall be drawn on warrant of the 22 secretary of finance and administration pursuant to vouchers 23 signed by the secretary of environment or the secretary's 24 authorized representative. Money in the fund is appropriated SFC/SB 30 25

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1 to the department for the sole purpose of assisting indigent 2 individuals or households that qualify for funding to 3 accomplish one of the following purposes where there is a real or potential negative impact to public health or water 4 5 quality from on-site liquid waste disposal system effluent: 6 to pay for a liquid waste disposal (1) system to replace a cesspool or other failed or improper 7 8 on-site liquid waste disposal system; 9 to purchase, install or maintain an (2) advanced treatment system as required by the Environmental 10 11 Improvement Act or regulations issued pursuant to that act; (3) to pay for the decommissioning and 12 removal of a cesspool or other failed or improper on-site 13 liquid waste disposal system; or 14 15 (4) to pay for all or a portion of the connection fees in order to connect an individual or 16 household to a centralized wastewater collection and 17 treatment system. 18 Β. Construction activities sponsored by the fund 19 20 shall be performed by licensed contractors selected through competitive bid by the department and shall be managed by the 21 department. 22 C. No more than five percent of the fund shall be 23 used by the department on an annual basis to pay for the 24 25 department costs associated with management and

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2 D. As used in this section: 3 "advanced treatment system" means an (1)on-site liquid wastewater treatment system that removes a 4 5 greater amount of contaminants than is accomplished by a 6 primary treatment system; "connection fee" means the fee paid 7 (2) 8 directly to a public water or wastewater system or other 9 wastewater management organization and does not include other 10 fees, such as legal fees, related to connecting an individual or household to a centralized wastewater collection and 11 treatment system; and 12 "indigent individuals or households" 13 (3) 14

14 means individuals or households whose annual incomes do not 15 exceed the federal poverty guidelines."

Section 2. Section 74-1-15 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 2000, Chapter 96, Section 3) is amended to read:

"74-1-15. LIQUID WASTE FUND CREATED.--The "liquid waste 18 fund" is created in the state treasury. On-site liquid waste 19 20 system fees shall be deposited in the fund. Money in the fund is appropriated to the department for administration of liquid 21 waste regulations, and no more than two hundred thousand 22 dollars (\$200,000) from unexpended money in the fund may be 23 transferred to the liquid waste disposal system assistance 24 fund, if enacted into law by the first session of the 25

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1	forty-ninth legislature. Disbursements from the fund shall be		
2	by warrant drawn by the secretary of finance and		
3	administration pursuant to vouchers signed by the secretary of		
4	environment or the secretary of environment's designee. Any		
5	unexpended or unencumbered balance or income earned from the		
6	money in the liquid waste fund remaining at the end of any
