12	Section 2. A new section of the Regional Transit
13	District Act is enacted to read:
14	"AUTHORIZATION TO EMPLOY COMMUTER RAIL SERVICE LAW
15	ENFORCEMENT OFFICERSPOWERS AND DUTIES OF OFFICERS
16	A. A district that operates a commuter rail
17	service may employ commuter rail service law enforcement
18	officers for the district and assign duties to the officers.
19	B. At all times while on duty, commuter rail
20	service law enforcement officers shall carry commissions of
21	office issued by the district. Commuter rail service law
22	enforcement officers shall have the powers of peace officers
23	on all property, tracks, rights of way, easements, vehicles,
24	buses, vans, railcars, locomotives and facilities owned,
25	leased, licensed, maintained or operated by the district.

1	Within this territory, a commuter rail service law	
2	enforcement officer may enforce all applicable laws,	
3	ordinances and regulations, but no arrest for violation of	
4	any law, ordinance or regulation is valid unless, at the time

7	(1) a distinctive badge bearing the name of
