B. The term "penalty assessment misdemeanor" does not include a violation that has caused or contributed to the cause of an accident resulting in injury or death to a person.

6 C. When an alleged violator of a penalty
7 assessment misdemeanor elects to accept a notice to appear in
8 lieu of a notice of penalty assessment, a fine imposed upon
9 later conviction shall not exceed the penalty assessment
10 established for the particular penalty assessment misdemeanor
11 and probation imposed upon a suspended or deferred sentence
12 shall not exceed ninety days.

D. The penalty assessment for speeding in
violation of Paragraph (4) of Subsection A of Section
66-7-301 NMSA 1978 is twice the penalty assessment
established in Subsection A of this section for the
equivalent miles per hour over the speed limit.

E. Upon a second conviction for operation without a permit for excessive size or weight pursuant to Section 66-7-413 NMSA 1978, the penalty assessment shall be two hundred fifty dollars (\$250). Upon a third or subsequent conviction, the penalty assessment shall be five hundred dollars (\$500)."_____
