BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO: Section 1. SUSPENSION OF CERTAIN REQUIREMENTS--PRECINCT BOUNDARY FREEZE--EXCEPTIONS.--

Α. For the purpose of redistricting following the 10 federal decennial census, the authority of boards of county 11 commissioners to create new precincts or to combine precincts 12 and to alter their boundaries pursuant to Section 1-3-2, 13 1-3-3 or 4-38-21 NMSA 1978 is suspended from July 1, 2009 14 15 until January 31, 2012, and all precinct boundaries are 16 frozen until January 31, 2012, except those precinct boundaries not in compliance with the provisions of the 17 Precinct Boundary Adjustment Act. 18

B. The secretary of state may authorize a board of county commissioners to adjust precinct boundaries in accordance with the Precinct Boundary Adjustment Act and shall notify the legislative council service of any adjustments.

C. The board of county commissioners and the 6 county clerks, upon receipt of the standard base maps from 7 the secretary of state, shall: 8 adjust all precinct boundaries to 9 (1) coincide with numbered or named street boundaries or suitable 10 11 visible terrain features shown on the standard base map; provided that the precincts shall be composed of contiguous 12 and compact areas, and state, county, municipal, school 13 district and other political boundary lines shall serve as 14 15 precinct boundaries whenever possible; and 16 (2) upon the completion of the precinct boundary adjustments as required in this section, indicate on 17 the standard base maps the boundaries for both urban and 18 nonurban precincts and, together with a written description 19 20 of the precincts, shall send an electronic copy in a format approved by the secretary of state or four copies of the 21 precinct maps to the secretary of state for approval. 22

D. The precincts shown upon the standard base maps
submitted pursuant to the provisions of this section and as
revised and approved by the secretary of state pursuant to SB 583

the Precinct Boundary Adjustment Act shall become the official precincts of each county for the 2011 redistricting. For the 2012 and subsequent primary and general elections, changes in precincts shall be made in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 1, Article 3 NMSA 1978.

E. A local public body, when creating or redrawing districts, shall not split a precinct into two or more districts for any elected office unless necessary to comply with federal law or to preserve communities of interest.

F. Precincts shall be designated solely by whole numbers."

Section 3. Section 1-3-13 NMSA 1978 (being Laws 1983, Chapter 223, Section 4, as amended) is amended to read:

"1-3-13. SECRETARY OF STATE POWERS AND DUTIES.--

15 Α. The secretary of state shall review all county precinct maps submitted pursuant to Section 1-3-12 NMSA 1978 16 for compliance with the provisions of the Precinct Boundary 17 Those county precinct maps determined not to Adjustment Act. 18 be in compliance with the precinct boundary criteria set 19 20 forth in Subsection A of Section 1-13-12 NMSA 1978 shall be rejected and returned to the appropriate county clerk with a 21 written statement setting forth those instances in which the 22 map does not comply. The county clerk and the board of 23 county commissioners shall make the required adjustments and 24 resubmit one copy of the corrected county precinct map within 25

2	B. Prior to January 1, 2012, if any precinct
