"public project" means the acquisition, 2 construction, improvement, alteration or reconstruction of 3 assets of a long-term capital nature by a qualified entity, including land; buildings; water rights; water, sewerage and 4 5 waste disposal systems; streets; airports; municipal 6 utilities; public recreational facilities; public transportation systems; parking facilities; and machinery, 7 8 furniture and equipment. "Public project" includes all proposed expenditures related to the entire undertaking. 9 10 "Public project" also includes the acquisition, construction or improvement of real property, buildings, facilities and 11 other assets by the authority for the purpose of leasing the 12 13 property;

F. "qualified entity" means the state or an agency 14 15 or institution of the state or a county, municipality, school district, two-year public post-secondary educational 16 institution, charter school, land grant corporation, acequia 17 association, public improvement district, federally chartered 18 college located in New Mexico, intercommunity water or 19 20 natural gas supply association or corporation, special water, drainage, irrigation or conservancy district or other special 21 district created pursuant to law, nonprofit foundation or 22 other support organization affiliated with a public 23 university, college or other higher educational institution 24 located in New Mexico, including a university research park 25

SFC/SB 584 Page 2 corporation, an Indian nation, tribe or pueblo located wholly or partially in New Mexico, including a political subdivision or a wholly owned enterprise of an Indian nation, tribe or pueblo or a consortium of those Indian entities or a consortium of any two or more qualified entities created pursuant to law; and

G. "security" or "securities", unless the context 7 8 indicates otherwise, means bonds, notes or other evidence of 9 indebtedness issued by a qualified entity or leases or 10 certificates or other evidence of participation in the lessor's interest in and rights under a lease with a 11 qualified entity and that are payable from taxes, revenues, 12 rates, charges, assessments or user fees or from the proceeds 13 of funding or refunding bonds, notes or other evidence of 14 15 indebtedness of a qualified entity or from certificates or evidence of participation in a lease with a qualified 16 entity." 17
