WHEREAS, New Mexico statutes relating to the organization and operation of two-year post-secondary institutions and programs have evolved in a haphazard manner over many years; and

WHEREAS, these statutes include those for branch community colleges in Chapter 21, Article 14 NMSA 1978, first codified by the New Mexico legislature in 1957, under which four branch community college campuses of New Mexico state university, four campuses of the university of New Mexico and two campuses of eastern New Mexico university currently operate; and

WHEREAS, these statutes include the Community College Act, enacted by the New Mexico legislature in 1963, under which six locally governed community colleges currently operate; and

WHEREAS, these statutes include the Technical and Vocational Institute Act, enacted in 1965, under which the central New Mexico community college currently operates; and

currently operate; and

WHEREAS, these statutes also include the College District Tax Act, the Learning Center Act and the Workforce Training Act, among others; and

WHEREAS, some provisions in these statutes may be obsolete, duplicative or no longer relevant to current practice; and

WHEREAS, there is a need to review and update these statutes to assure the legislature that the legal framework relating to two-year post-secondary institutions is adequate to meet current and future requirements;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE 12 STATE OF NEW MEXICO that the higher education department, in 13 cooperation with the state's two-year post-secondary 14 15 institutions and the public education department, where appropriate, be requested to conduct a thorough review of all 16 relevant New Mexico statutes for adequacy and appropriateness 17 and to develop recommendations for modification to be 18 presented to the second session of the forty-ninth 19 20 legislature.____ SM 75 Page 2
