SUMMARY

Synopsis of HTRC Substitute

The House Taxation and Revenue Committee substitute for House Bill 903 extends the purpose for which the revenue from the county environmental services gross receipts tax may be used to include renewable energy facilities and systems.

Because no effective date is provided in the bill, its provisions will become effective June 19, 2009, ninety (90) days after the 2009 legislative session adjourns.

FISCAL IMPLICATIONS

This bill will have no fiscal impact because it does not alter the rate of the tax nor does it alter who can impose the tax but rather it simply expands the use of the revenue from the tax.
