22	adopt variable school calendars; and			
23	WHEREAS, local school boards are authorized to approve			
24	individual school calendars and determine school policy in

WHEREAS, the public education department notes that it is questionable whether students receive the benefit of instructional hours with such incremental increases;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the study also examine the effect of this practice on professional development for teachers and learning time and achievement of students; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the office of education accountability report its findings and recommendations, if any, to the legislative education study committee before September 30, 2009; and
