24	fifty-six thousand wells producing oil; and
25	WHEREAS, the oil and gas industry provides nearly thirty

WHEREAS, in fiscal year 2008, the oil and gas industry was estimated to generate almost three billion dollars (\$3,000,000,000) in direct revenue to the state; and

WHEREAS, New Mexico's school children are the primary beneficiaries of the oil and gas industry, which provides hundreds of millions of dollars each year to education through royalties paid to the land grant permanent fund; and

WHEREAS, technological advances have made oil production cleaner, safer and more efficient; and

WHEREAS, without a strong and thriving oil and gas industry in New Mexico, the state's educational system, roads, public facilities, economy and other institutions would have to rely much more on funding from other sources;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE SENATE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO that February 28, 2009 be declared "Oil and Gas Industry Day" in the senate; and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that heartfelt gratitude and deep appreciation be extended to the New Mexico oil and gas industry for its many contributions to the state.
