AN ACT

RELATING TO THE GENERAL APPROPRIATION ACT OF 2009; ENACTING NEW SECTIONS TO REDUCE CERTAIN GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATIONS FOR FISCAL YEAR 2010 AND TO MAKE APPROPRIATIONS.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. A new section of the General Appropriation Act of 2009 is enacted to read:

"~~[NEW MATERIAL]~~ APPROPRIATION REDUCTIONS.--The amounts set out under the general fund column in Section 4 of the General Appropriation Act of 2009 are reduced by sixteen and three-tenths percent rounded to the nearest one hundred dollars (\$100) except as follows:

A. the developmental disabilities support program of the department of health by zero percent;

B. the medical assistance program of the human

2 C. the instruction and general purposes category

5 D. every other category in Subsection J, Higher

9 Section 2. A new section of the General Appropriation Act
10 of 2009 is enacted to read:

11 "[NEW MATERIAL] FEDERAL STIMULUS FUNDS--AMERICAN RECOVERY
12 AND REINVESTMENT ACT OF 2009.--Ninety-one million dollars
13 (\$91,000,000) remaining from the American Recovery and
14 Reinvestment Act of 2009 allocation to the state through the
15 education fund of the state fiscal stabilization fund shall be
16 distributed to school districts through the state equalization
17 guarantee distribution for fiscal year 2010."
