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AN ACT

RELATING TO CAPITAL OUTLAY; REVERTING BALANCES OF CERTAIN
GENERAL FUND APPROPRIATIONS; TRANSFERRING BALANCES TO THE
GENERAL FUND; AUTHORIZING CERTAIN SEVERANCE TAX BOND
APPROPRIATIONS; PROVIDING FOR REVERSION OF CERTAIN BALANCES;
DECLARING AN EMERGENCY.

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO:

Section 1. GENERAL FUND BALANCES REVERTED.--

Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, the
unexpended balance up to the amount specified of the
following appropriations shall not be expended and shall
revert to the general fund pursuant to procedures, policies
and deadlines established by the financial control division
of the department of finance and administration:

1. four hundred thousand dollars (\$400,000) to the
aging and long-term services department in Subsection 27 of
Section 33 of Chapter 92 of Laws 2008 to purchase and equip
vehicles for senior centers nationwide on the Navajo Nation
in McKinley, San Juan, Cibola, Bernalillo and Sandoval

2. one million five hundred thousand dollars

1 APPROPRIATION OF PROCEEDS.--

2 A. The state board of finance may issue and sell
3 severance tax bonds in compliance with the Severance Tax
4 Bonding Act in an amount not to exceed the total of the
5 amounts authorized for purposes specified in this act. The
6 state board of finance shall schedule the issuance and sale
7 of the bonds in the most expeditious and economical manner
8 possible upon a finding by the board that the project has
9 been developed sufficiently to justify the issuance and that
10 the project can proceed to contract within a reasonable time.
11 The state board of finance shall further take the appropriate
12 steps necessary to comply with the Internal Revenue Code of
13 1986, as amended. Proceeds from the sale of the bonds are
14 appropriated for the purposes specified in this act.

15 B. The agencies named in this act shall certify to
16 the state board of finance when the money from the proceeds
17 of the severance tax bonds authorized in this section is
18 needed for the purposes specified in the applicable section
19 of this act. If an agency has not certified the need for the
20 issuance of the bonds for a particular project, including
21 projects that have been reauthorized, by the end of fiscal
22 year 2011, the authorization for that project is void.

23 C. Before an agency may certify for the issuance
24 of severance tax bonds, the project must be developed
25 sufficiently so that the agency reasonably expects to:

1 (1) incur within six months after the
2 applicable bonds have been issued a substantial binding
3 obligation to a third party to expend at least five percent
4 of the bond proceeds for the project; and

5 (2) spend at least eighty-five percent of
6 the bond proceeds within three years after the applicable
7 bonds have been issued.

8 D. Except as otherwise specifically provided by
9 law:

20 Section 4. PUBLIC SCHOOL CAPITAL OUTLAY FUND--TRANSFERS
21 TO GENERAL FUND.--

22 A. Thirty-one million six hundred thousand dollars
23 (\$31,600,000) is transferred from the public school capital
24 outlay fund to the general fund for the purpose of meeting
25 appropriations from the general fund. The money transferred

1 represents the remaining portion of the amount of the general
2 fund appropriation made in Laws 2006, Chapter 111, Section 66
3 that has been allocated to school districts for the state
4 share of projects pursuant to Section 22-24-5.7 NMSA 1978 but
5 that has not yet been expended.

6 B. Twenty million dollars (\$20,000,000) is
7 transferred from the public school capital outlay fund to the
8 general fund for the purpose of meeting appropriations from
9 the general fund. The money transferred represents the
10 amount transferred from the general fund to the public school
11 capital outlay fund in Subsection C of Section 12 of the
12 General Appropriation Act of 2009.

13 Section 5. SEVERANCE TAX BOND APPROPRIATIONS TO THE
14 PUBLIC SCHOOL CAPITAL OUTLAY FUND.--Pursuant to the
15 provisions of Section 2 of this act, upon certification by
16 the public school capital outlay council that the need exists
17 for the issuance of the bonds, the following amounts are
18 appropriated to the public school capital outlay fund for the
19 following purposes, and any unexpended or unencumbered
20 balance shall not revert:

21 A. thirty-one million six hundred thousand dollars
22 (\$31,600,000) for the purpose of meeting allocations made in
23 Laws 2006, Chapter 111, Section 66 to school districts for
24 the state share of the projects pursuant to Section 22-24-5.7
25 NMSA 1978; and

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B. twenty million dollars (\$20,000,000) to carry out the purposes of the Public School Capital Outlay Act.

Section 6. EMERGENCY.--It is necessary for the public peace, health and safety that this act take effect immediately.
