20	A. The state game commission may designate by rule
21	special management areas on the San Juan river, below Navajo
22	dam, as trophy fisheries management areas. Any person angling
23	in a trophy fisheries management area is required to purchase a
24	San Juan river special management permit in addition to a valid
25	fishing license and other required validations.
